APPOINTMENT OF OFFICERS

<u>Section 1</u>: I hereby appoint <u>Randy Richmond</u> as the <u>Chapter 201 Chaplain</u>. The duties of the Chapter Chaplain include, but are not limited to:

- (a) Conducting Invocation and Benediction prayers at all meetings.
- (b) Conducting prayers and services for Chapter patriotic observances such as Memorial Day, POW/MIA Ceremony, etc.
- (c) Perform visitations to Chapter members in dire straits and/or in medical facilities as appropriate.
- (d) Conducting gravesite prayers and services for Chapter members as required or requested.

<u>Section 2</u>: I hereby appoint <u>Bill McCorquodale</u> as the <u>Chapter 201 Assistant Chaplain</u>. The duty of the Assistant Chaplain is to support and assist the Chapter Chaplain and fulfill the duties of the Chapter Chaplain in his absence.

<u>Section 3</u>: I hereby appoint <u>John Hassenplug</u> as the <u>Chapter 201 Sergeant-At-Arms</u>. The Chapter 201 Sergeant-At-Arms is responsible for maintaining reasonable and proper decorum at all meetings of the Chapter. Duties of the Sergeant-At-Arms include, but are not limited to the following:

- (a) Prepare the meeting facility, including proper arrangement of seating and the placement of appropriate National and VVA colors as required.
- (b) Announcement and introduction of guests.
- (c) Insure that all members and guests are properly registered on the Secretaries sign-in sheet.
- (d) The Sergeant-At-Arms shall present the opening and closing salute and lead the gathering

(e) The Sergeant-At-Arms is responsible for the Chapter colors and their stands. This responsibility includes ensuring that they are available for all patriotic observances that the Chapter participates in.

<u>Section 4</u>: I hereby appoint <u>Gerald Arnold</u> as the <u>Chapter 201 Veteran Service Officer (VSO)</u> and a Palo Alto Veterans Affairs Voluntary Service (VAVS) Representative. Duties of the Chapter VSO and Palo Alto VAVS Representative include, but are not limited to the following:

- (a) Assist Veterans in the preparation of claims and appeals for compensation due to service-connected disability.
- (b) Assist Veterans in finding other benefits due regardless of the era in which they served.
- (c) Act as the Vietnam Veterans of America Chapter 201 Veteran Services Representative at the Palo Alto VA.
- (d) Interface with the California National Service Officer (VVA.VSO.LB@gmail.com) on Veteran Service benefit questions, concerns and assistance.

<u>Section 5</u>: I hereby appoint <u>Randy Richmond</u> as a <u>Chapter 201 Liaison Officer</u> to the Chapter 201 Associates to the Vietnam Veterans of America.
